BLOOD DONATION CAMP AND DISTRIBUTION OF COMPUTERS AND BLANKETS UNDER CIVIC ACTION PROGRAMME AT BSF CAMPUS HQRS SPECIAL DG (EASTERN COMMAND) GURUSADAY ROAD, KOLKATA

1. BSF Wives Welfare Association (BWWA) in collaboration with NGO Team 'SHREE RAM SEVA SAMITY TRUST', 'PROJECT LIFE FORCE' & 'SWA RNYM FOUNDATION CHARITABLE TRUST' Kolkata organised a Civic Action Programme at BSF Campus Gurusaday Road, Kolkata.
2. In this programme on 14th Dec 2017, a Blood donation camp was organized by BSF Wives Welfare Association (BWWA), in collaboration with NGO team 'PROJECT LIFE FORCE', Kolkata. During the programme, 70 Force personnel from BSF donated blood under the supervision of Dr. Prasun Maiti, CMO(SG) BSF. Smt Renu Sharma, President BWWA, New Delhi was present in the programme as Chief Guest. During the programme Smt Renu Sharma, President BWWA, New Delhi handed over 10 Nos of Computer which were provided by 'Shree Ram Seva Samity Trust' for children of border population and Jawans for coaching for vocational courses by Prep Mantra to Smt. Pubali Sonowal, Regional BWWA President SHQ BSF Kolkata and Smt Aparna Anjaneyulu, BWWA President handed over 400 Nos of Blanket to BWWA Members of 27 Bn BSF under civic action programme for further distribution to border population of Sunderbans area.
3. Smt Aparna Anjaneyulu, BWWA President South Bengal Frontier, Smt Madhu Lohia, BWWA President Spl DG (Eastern Command) and Smt. Pubali Sonowal, Regional BWWA President, Sector Kolkata came forward and actively extended their services and guidance to help organise this noble programme. BSF always remains in the forefront to conduct such programmes from time to time especially in border areas which includes Civic Action Programmes besides organising Medical Camps etc. These programmes are mostly conducted independently and sometimes with the help of NGO's, whenever required thus contributing positively in the betterment of lives of fellow citizens.
