### BSF ORAGANISED A CANCER AWARENESS CAMP AT TAGOREVILLA, KOLKATA

On 9<sup>th</sup> Feb 2018, a Cancer Awareness Camp was organised by BSF at Tagorevilla, Kolkata in collaboration with BSF Wives Welfare Association (BWVA) and NGO Khardah Manan for awareness of the BSF personnel, their families and civil population under the supervision of Dr. Sujit Basu, M.D. Ph.D. (Professor) Oncology Specialist of the Ohio State University, Columbus, USA.

During the awareness programme, BSF personnel, their families and civil population were briefed by Dr. Sujit Basu, M.D. Ph.D. (Professor) Oncology Specialist and Dr. P K Mitra about the causes of cancer, prevention measures and treatment available in medical science.
